### SANCO activities on AMR

- AMR included in Commissioner Dalli's "100 days planning"
  - Holistic approach
  - 5-year strategy to be planned
- Coordination between public health, animal health and welfare, food safety, pharmaceuticals, biocides, research, international cooperation improved






## Staff working paper on AMR

- Provide overview of ongoing EU activities related to AMR
- Initiate a holistic reflection and discussion on AMR, to identify possible areas for further action and the types of possible actions
- Public consultation ended 31.3.2010
  - summary under preparation









## Monitoring – reported by EFSA

### Monitoring

- AMR prevalence in zoonotic agents (directive 2003/99/EC)
- Harmonised monitoring of AMR in Salmonella in poultry and pigs
- Harmonised monitoring of AMR in Campylobacter in broilers
- Harmonised monitoring of MRSA in breeding pigs in 2008 – report published
- MRSA risk factors in breeding pigs report will be
- published in April 2010





## **Opinions**

- EMEA: 1) use of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> generation cephalosporinases, 2) use of macrolides, lincosamides and streptogramins in animals
- MRSA reports: 1) EMEA, 2) EFSA and 3) joint EMEA/EFSA/ECDC
- Joint EFSA, EMEA, ECDC, SCENIHR opinion on antimicrobial resistance focused on zoonotic infections





## New and on going requests

- EMA: project on monitoring the sales and uses of antimicrobials in animals – started 2009
- EFSA: mandate on ESC (extended spectrum cephalosporinases) in food and food producing animals new





#### International activities

- CODEX alimentarius ad hoc Intergovernmental Task Force
  - finalised 2010
  - outcome: guidelines on risk analysis on AMR
- TATFAR = transatlantic task force on AMR
  - Established by EU-US summit in 2009
  - Aim to identify areas for further cooperation and to suggest them to the summit 2011





## Specific WG on AMR

- Commission WG on AMR scheduled23 April 2010
  - Exchange of views of future steps on food- and animal-borne AMR
    - Monitoring
    - Risk assessment
    - Risk management!
